Kits for Clients

NWPP believes that everyone moving into a new apartment – especially those moving from homelessness or temporary housing – should have brand new bedding, and an array of kitchen and dining supplies. NWPP makes arrangement for a new mattress, box spring and bed frame, and then provides each client with a Bedding Kit and a Kitchen Kit.

Support NWPP by donating complete kits

While the search for housing is challenging, NWPP continues to successfully place low-income seniors in housing. Each year, approximately 250 clients are placed into housing. The bedding and kitchen kits add a personal and comforting touch.

Bedding Kits:

- Twin or double sheet set, with pillowcases
- Two standard pillows
- One set towels (bath, hand and wash cloth)
- Blanket or quilt
- Shower curtain and curtain rings
- Plastic clothes basket

Kitchen Kits:

- Two of each: dinner plates, mugs, bowls, glasses, place mats
- Silverware for two
- Kitchen towels and potholders
- Sauce pan and fry pan
- Paring knife and can opener
- Measuring spoons and cups
- Serving spoons
- Reusable shopping bag
