Call for information. Safety assessments to access shelter can be completed through the agency or with another agency (Call to Safety, Gateway Center).

Bradley Angle House: 503-281-2442 (24 hour access line)
(for women, men and people who identify as transgender)
Each individual and family is provided their own room. Bathroom and shower is shared.

Raphael House: 503-222-6222
(individuals and children fleeing domestic violence)
Separate rooms for each family. Families share a bathroom with 1 other family.

Clackamas Women's Services Emergency Shelter: 503-654-2288
(for women and children) Separate rooms for each family. Shared bathrooms, kitchen, and communal spaces.
