

FRIENDLY VISITOR PROGRAM

Program Overview

The Friendly Visitor Program connects well trained volunteers with low-income seniors (age 55+) in Multnomah County who may be isolated or in need of social connection.

What Volunteers Do

- Provide weekly or bi-weekly social visits
- Offer companionship and conversation
- Help combat loneliness and isolation
- Support seniors in staying connected to the community
- Participate in light social activities (no personal care or medical tasks)

Visit Options

- In-home visits
- Community outings (walks, coffee, activities)
- Occasional phone check-ins

Participant Eligibility

- Age 55+
- Reside in Multnomah County
- Low-income
- Experiencing isolation or barriers to social connection
- Participant in Northwest Pilot Project Housing Program

Volunteer Information

- Volunteers are screened and trained (application link below)
- Matched based on interests, personality, location, and availability
- Consistent, reliable visits are expected
